have underlying **histological inflammation**  
despite endoscopic mucosal healing<sup>a,1</sup>

**Unresolved histologic inflammation**  
in patients with Crohn's disease has been  
associated with **complications, steroid**  
**use, hospitalization and/or surgery**<sup>2,3</sup>
